Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year! We are very excited to welcome our students and staff back! Please be aware of the following information regarding timetables and significant dates. Also check the school's website and Facebook/Instagram pages regularly.

Date	Event	Information
August 20, 2021	Student Timetables Available	Student timetables will be available for viewing on PowerSchool. Students/Parents need to login to PowerSchool to view them.
August 23, 2021	School/Office Opens	This is the first day the school/office will be open.
August 23, 2021 and August 24, 2021	Picture Day	Students will be asked to sign-up for an appointment slot.
August 31, 2021	Grade 10 Welcome Day	This is the first day of school for Grade 10 students. Only Grade 10 students attend on this day.
September 1, 2021	Grade 11 and 12 Students First Day	All students attend school on this day. This will be the first day of classes for Grade 11 and 12 students.
September 7, 2021	Make-Up Picture Day	Students who were not able to have their picture taken on August 23 or 24 will need to have their picture done on this day.

ID Card/Bus Passes

ALL students (both in person and online) will need to have their school picture taken for their school ID and the yearbook. Our school's Picture Days will be held on August 23 and 24 (8:00 am - 4:00 pm). Students are required to SIGN UP for a time slot using this link: <https://lifetouch.as.me/NDHS>. Please sign up as soon as possible! If you are not able to attend on one of these designated days, Make-Up Picture Day will be on September 7.

Students who require a Bus Pass to ride the City Transit will be able to pick them up in the office.

Lockers will be provided by students' TAG teacher on the first day of classes.

Timetable Changes
