<u>Timetable Change Requests:</u> With semester 2 right around the corner, students may require a timetable change. The process is described below:

- We have implemented a new timetable change process this year. This <u>link</u> takes you to our website that explains in detail the process and the required form to start the process of asking for a timetable change. Timetable requests can be made for the following reasons:
 - o You need a particular course to meet graduation / post-secondary entrance requirements.
 - You have 'See Counsellor' in one of your periods
 - You have an incomplete timetable.
- Our counsellors will begin working on timetable changes in mid-January. Forms will be returned sharing the status of the request via email.
- Timetable change requests will be open from January 17 26.
- Only one timetable request / student will be honored.

Semester Change Over:

- Last day of classes for semester 1 is January 19. Final Exams will be begin on January 20. Semester 2 classes start on February 1.
