

# William Arthur Bower Memorial Bursary

The William Arthur Bower Memorial Bursary was established in the fall of 2021 to honour the memory of William Arthur Bower, who served voluntarily in the first World War. Arthur, as he was known, was killed in action at the age of 22 on June 29, 1916, and placed importance on higher education.

Successful applicants will receive \$5,000 towards their post-secondary tuition. The award will be available to five high school students who graduated from 100% publicly funded schools within the boundaries of the City of Red Deer, from Red Deer School Division and Red Deer Catholic Separate School Division. Applicants must be planning to pursue full-time studies in a certificate, diploma, or degree program at a post-secondary institution within Canada.

#### **Application Process:**

Completed applications must be submitted to your high school Career Counsellor by 3:30 pm on Monday, May 9, 2022.

Your submission must contain the following:

- 1. Completed application form, with attached required documents
- 2. Two signed and dated reference letters (one must be from a teacher, administrator, or counsellor)
- 3. A copy of your detailed academic report
- 4. A copy of your offer of admission, or proof of enrolment
- 5. A copy of your parent(s)/legal guardian(s) Notice of Assessments from the most recent tax year must be attached to your application

Applicants may be contacted by the bursary selection committee to schedule an in-person interview to determine recipients for the award.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- 1. Hold Canadian citizenship or permanent residency
- 2. Must be enrolled in a program leading to the completion of a certificate, diploma or degree program at a post-secondary institution within Canada
- 3. Preference may be given to applicants with financial need
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate a commitment to making the community better through volunteerism and/or contributions to the community.

The bursary, established in fall 2021, will be initially awarded only to students who are graduating in June, 2022. Students who plan to take one gap year are eligible to apply. Funds will not be forwarded to recipients until confirmation of enrolment has been provided to the Red Deer & District Community Foundation. Funds will be forwarded directly to the recipient's post-secondary institution to be applied towards tuition and fees.
