Use your creativity to voice anti-racism in our community. Create artwork, poems or stories that reflect a better tomorrow. Resources listed on brochure for inspiration.

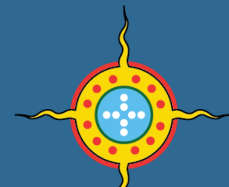
